A BILL

To restore the traditional day of observance of Memorial Day.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RESTORATION OF TRADITIONAL DAY OF OB-**
4 **SERVANCE OF MEMORIAL DAY.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION OF LEGAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY.—
6 Section 6103(a) of title 5, United States Code, is amended
7 in the item relating to Memorial Day by striking “the last
8 Monday in May.” and inserting “May 30.”.

9 (b) OBSERVANCES AND CEREMONIES.—Section 116
10 of title 36, United States Code, is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “The last
2 Monday in May” and inserting “May 30”; and

3 (2) in subsection (b)—

4 (A) by striking “and” at the end of para-
5 graph (3);

6 (B) by redesignating paragraph (4) as
7 paragraph (5); and

8 (C) by inserting after paragraph (3) the
9 following new paragraph (4):

10 “(4) calling on the people of the United States
11 to observe Memorial Day as a day of ceremonies for
12 showing respect for American veterans of wars and
13 other military conflicts; and”.

14 (c) DISPLAY OF FLAG.—Section 6(d) of title 4,
15 United States Code, is amended by striking “the last Mon-
16 day in May;” and inserting “May 30;”.
